Scope

Perspectives in Environmental and Systems Biology will emphasize the inter- and cross-disciplinary character of systems biology, and integrate contributions of various classical disciplines ranging from molecular and cellular biology to medicine and ecology, informatics and applied mathematics. It will discuss topics such as multi-scale approaches, the analysis of networks, computational modeling, systems biology in medicine, and synthetic biology. The conference will thus attract a wide range of scientists, including biologists, physicians, chemists, and computer scientists.

Grenoble Alpes University is strongly promoting systems biology. The conference will celebrate the first five years of the Federal Research Structure Environmental and Systems Biology (BEeSy) and the inauguration of the new Xavier Leverve BEeSy research building.



A specific session will be dedicated to the late Prof. Xavier Leverve, physician, former scientific director of INRA and laboratory director, who was a driving force for integrative approaches in bioenergetics and nutrition.

Subscription

In order to become a partner or to book an exhibition space, please send back a booking form to the Conference office together with a deposit of 40% of the above-mentioned total. The balance of the invoice (60%) shall be payable at latest by Fevrier 12, 2015. No bookings can be accepted verbally. The booking and the settlement of the down payment are a fixed commitment and place the subscriber under obligation to accept the general & particular conditions of the partnership file and of the technical manual for the exhibitor (to be sent at a later date to all companies which have booked an exhibition stand). Furthermore, non-settlement of payment of the balance of the invoice by Fevrier 12, 2015 will entail immediate cancellation, in law, of the right to take up the requested bookings, with no reimbursement of the down payment paid.

Position and site plan

Stands will be allocated according to the sequence of receipt of bookings. After allocation, no change of position can be implemented without the organizers' written approval.

The exhibition plan as set out in this document is not contractually binding. It is placed subject to approval from the Grenoble city council. We reserve the right to modify both the size and the arrangement of the exhibitor's booked areas hand-in-hand with approvals issued by the city council.

Cancellation

Any cancellation of a booking for a stand, symposium or other partnership options must be made by registered mail to the Conference office and shall be placed subject to the following cancellation conditions:

Before January 12, 2015: 25% of the total amount owing, including tax, will not be repayable.

From January 13, 2015 to February 12, 2015: 50% of the total amount owing, including tax, will not be repayable.

From February 12, 2015: no reimbursement of sums owing & paid.

Force majeure

In the event of force majeure, it will be possible for the dates of the Conference and of the Exhibition to be modified or those events may purely & simply be cancelled.
